



Avalon Sailing Club Boat Care & Safety Principles

Teaching children how to look after boats and sail safely is a prime objective of our club. We would appreciate if you could read - and explain to your child/ren - the standards below, so they understand how to take care of boats and sail safely in them.

Sailing rules

1. No deliberate collisions.

Boat Care

1. Never put a boat down on anything else but a cradle or the water.
2. Never drag boats up the beach or onto rocks.
3. Take care when carrying the boats to the water, look up to make sure the mast or sail doesn't get caught on the corner of the clubhouse.
4. Wash boats down after use and make sure they have the drains and inspection ports removed so they dry out.
5. Check that there is no water left in buoyancy tanks, sponge out if required.
6. Ensure boats and all their equipment is put away & covers on at end of use.

I have read and understand the above.

My child understands these rules. We will look after the Avalon Sailing Club boats and have fun and safe days sailing.
